Nebraska Orthopaedic Hospital is licensed as an acute care hospital by the State of Nebraska. We meet and exceed all of the requirements to be a hospital. Nebraska Orthopaedic Hospital is certified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) meaning we are able to provide care for individuals who participate in these government sponsored programs.

Our nursing staff consists of high quality registered nurses, all of whom are ACLS (Advanced Cardiac Life Support) certified. We maintain excellent nursing to staff ratios in all areas of the hospital. This means we have more nurses available for the care of our patients. Although a physician is not onsite 24-hours a day, seven days a week, your surgeon, an internal or family medicine physician and an anesthesiologist are always on call to respond to medical emergencies and provide direction for follow-up care.

Nebraska Orthopaedic Hospital has access to a wide variety of physician specialists who are consulted based on patient needs. Be assured that following surgery, and through the recovery room process, a physician is onsite in the hospital. To meet your medical needs, we also have the ability to stabilize and transfer patients to other area medical facilities if a different type or level of care is needed.
